These latter I have placed in italics so as to separate them from the original notes this author made during his lengthy sojourn. In this way it can be seen why the impressions were made and whether any new comments would add any help to a future traveler reading this narrative. This of course is not meant to be a travel guide such as the many hundreds that can be found in many editions everywhere they are sold. Rather it is merely meant to convey an approach to travel itself for those who are more travel than tourist minded.
